



Welcome to Vienna: ANA to Launch Daily Flight Service to Tokyo

A new long-haul flight connection will be offered from Vienna. All Nippon Airways, Japan's largest airline, will link Vienna with Tokyo-Haneda Airport starting on February 17, 2019. The new route will be served daily throughout the entire year, with the airline deploying a state-of-the-art Boeing 787-9 (Dreamliner).

Daily flights from Vienna to Tokyo-Haneda in the Dreamliner

ANA will operate daily flights between Vienna and Tokyo as of February 2019. The aircraft will depart from Tokyo at 1:55 a.m. and arrive in Vienna at 6 a.m. The return flight from Vienna will leave at 11:50 a.m. and land in Tokyo at 6:55 a.m. The airline will deploy a state-of-the-art Boeing 787.9 Dreamliner, with 215 comfortable seats in a pleasant atmosphere.
