



Vienna Airport: Laudamotion Now Takes Off to More Than 20 New Destinations

Three million bookings since the airline launched operations in the spring of 2018

Laudamotion is on a growth path. The low-cost airline is expanding its flight offering in the 2018/19 winter season by adding more than 20 popular city and holiday destinations to its portfolio. Since it began operating, Laudamotion has registered more than three million bookings, and expects five million passengers in 2019. “Laudamotion is providing strong growth impetus to the Vienna flight hub”, says a pleased Julian Jäger, Joint CEO and COO of Vienna Airport, commenting on the development of Laudamotion. The new flight connections were officially opened today, October 29, 2018, within the context of a press event held by Laudamotion and Flughafen Wien AG.

“With the inauguration of new routes by Laudamotion, passengers will have even a greater selection of travel destinations. This makes the winter flight schedule at Vienna Airport more multi-faceted than ever before. Laudamotion is on a growth path and will thus make a major contribution to the upcoming passenger record at Vienna Airport”, states Julian Jäger, Joint CEO and COO of Vienna Airport.

“Laudamotion is focusing on growth. For this reason, we are even more pleased to be able to more than double our presence here in Vienna effective immediately. By offering flight service to 22 new destinations, we open up new travel possibilities for our passengers. Our flight connections are ideal, both for leisure and business travellers. We rely on our customer-oriented fare concept with an unbeatable price-performance ratio and are extremely pleased to be able to offer so many new direct flight connections from Vienna” says Andreas Gruber, CEO of Laudamotion.

Europe, Marrakech or Amman: Laudamotion takes passengers to their city or beach holidays

Numerous new flight connections are now available effective immediately in the expanded flight offering of Laudamotion. Daily flights are offered to Dublin (IR), Barcelona (ES), Milan (ES), Madrid (ES), Rome (IT), Bucharest (RO) and London (GB). The airline flies four times per week to Bologna (IT), Krakow (PL) and Valencia (ES). Laudamotion offers three weekly flights to Paris (FR) and Copenhagen (DK), and two flights each week to Amman (JO), Marrakech (MA), Faro (PT), Larnaca (CY), Gran Canary/Las Palmas (ES), Seville (ES) and Tenerife (ES) as well as one weekly flight each to Lanzarote (ES) and Fuerte Ventura (ES). The three weekly flight connections to Malaga (ES) in the summer flight schedule as well as the daily flights to Palma de Mallorca (ES) will be continued during the winter season.

Record achieved at Laudamotion: Three million bookings

The Austrian airline can be satisfied with the lively interest displayed by travellers. The low-cost carrier has also registered three million bookings since it commenced operations in the spring of 2018. Up to five million passengers are expected to fly with Laudamotion in 2019.

The low-cost airline Laudamotion was founded in March 2018 by Niki Lauda, who lent his name to the company. The current fleet operates using the code OE and consists of 19 Airbus aircraft. The airline's headquarters are located in Vienna, and the airline has bases in Austria and Germany. Laudamotion serves a total of 49 destinations in 18 countries, and boasts a flexible, customer-oriented ticket price concept with an unbeatable price-performance ratio.
