



EasyJet Returns to Vienna: New Direct Flight Connection from Vienna to Milan as of March 2025

There will be an expanded flight offering within Europe. Starting in March 2025, easyJet, one of Europe's largest low-cost carriers, will launch flight service linking Vienna with Milan Linate Airport. The airline will operate daily flights, deploying a state-of-the-art Airbus A320. The British airline terminated flights from Vienna in March 2020 as a consequence of the coronavirus pandemic and is now returning to Vienna Airport with a new direct flight connection.

"Welcome back, easyJet! After a four-year interruption, we are resuming our long-standing and good cooperation. As of March 2025, the new flight connection will bring an expanded flight offering to passengers travelling to the popular fashion and art metropolis of Milan. The bustling city in Northern Italy is always worth a visit. Thus, the first new additions to the summer flight schedule of Vienna Airport have been announced," states Julian Jäger, Joint CEO and COO of Vienna Airport.

"With the opening of our new bases in Milan Linate and Rome Fiumicino, we will also be able to further expand our offer for Austrian travellers to Italy from 2025 and are pleased to offer even more attractive travel options for their next trip to Italy with the new direct connection between Vienna and Milan Linate," said Thomas Haagensen, Managing Director easyJet Europe.

Daily flight linking Vienna to Milan-Linate deploying an Airbus A320

EasyJet will operate daily flights between Vienna and Milan-Linate starting on the 30th of March 2025. The aircraft will take off from Milan at 1.25 pm and arrive in Vienna at 2.50 pm. The return flight from Vienna will leave at 3.25 pm and land in Milan at 4.55 pm. The airline will deploy a modern Airbus A320 on the Vienna-Milan route.

EasyJet was founded in 1995. Headquartered in Luton, Great Britain, it is now of Europe's leading low-cost carriers at present. The airline operates a fleet of over 350 aircraft, mainly the Airbus A320 family, and operates fights to 150+ airports in more than 35 countries.
