





Austrian cutting-edge space technology starts in AirportCity: world market leader ENPULSION will in future produce groundbreaking high-tech satellite drives at Vienna Airport

The Austrian world market leader for micro and nano satellite drives ENPULSION is expanding its production capacities and will be located in the AirportCity at Vienna Airport in summer 2023. In the future, drives for space satellites will be produced here, including for projects of the European Space Agency (ESA). Right from the start, around 80 employees will work for the world market leader in the field of micro- and nano-satellite technology at the airport location, with the prospect of further expansion.

"With ENPULSION, an innovative technology world market leader from Austria with 100% export share comes to the airport and uses the unique location advantages of AirportCity. This strengthens our orientation as an innovation hub and offers excellent further development opportunities. We are therefore very pleased about ENPULSION's decision in favor of AirportCity as the new operating and production site." says Günther Ofner, CFO of Vienna Airport.

World market leader from Austria: ENPULSION

From summer 2023, ENPULSION will set up a production facility for drives for micro and nanosatellites on around 4,000 m² in Office Parks 2 and 4. Investments are also being made in close cooperation with research institutions at the Wiener Neustadt site. The innovative manufacturer of satellite propulsion systems has been supplying leading aerospace companies worldwide since 2016 and, due to its rapid growth, has become the world market leader with soon 200 engines in space, more than 300 engines delivered and a cumulative time of "on-orbit operation" of 150 years.

A perfect business location: Vienna AirportCity

Vienna Airport is the perfect business location for companies: With four office parks, AirportCity offers extensive office space in all dimensions. The highlight is Office Park 4, the most modern and sustainable office building in Austria. Office Park 4 offers around 26,000 m² of office and conference space on ten levels for around 2,500 employees. The building has received multiple awards for its sustainability: The heat is supplied by geothermal energy with 450 energy poles in the ground, a photovoltaic system on the building roof supplies electricity from solar energy.

The AirportCity Space in Office Park 4 is a state-of-the-art co-working and event center for companies and events of all sizes. With its own transport infrastructure and excellent road, rail and air connections, a medical center, a fitness center, two hotel facilities, numerous shopping and dining options and state-of-the-art office, co-working and event facilities,





the AirportCity is a perfect location for companies looking for new business locations for their offices or conferencing and event areas. More than 230 companies are represented at the airport site, more than 20,000 people are employed here.
