

What can I take on board?

The following list shows items that can be taken on board and those that are prohibited.

Item	allowed/prohibited
Baby food, bottle	allowed in hand luggage including baby food and liquids (sufficient for the duration of the flight)
Baby power, face powder	allowed in hand luggage
Batteries	normal batteries (lithium ion as in mobile phones, digital cameras) are allowed; please contact the airline for special needs (e.g. wet-cell batteries)
Cameras, tripod	allowed in hand luggage, no restrictions on normal batteries
Cane, crutches, walking sticks	allowed in hand luggage
Contact lens fluid	allowed in hand luggage, see liquid medication
Disposable razors	allowed in hand luggage
Electronic appliances	allowed in hand luggage, laptop and tablets need to be removed from carry-on baggage before screening
Empty bottles, other empty containers such as jars	allowed in hand luggage
Hairdryer	allowed in hand luggage
Implants	no restrictions; medical certificate not necessary as manual check is carried out; it is advisable to carry your ID card if available
Lip gloss	allowed in hand luggage, max. 1 litre in a plastic bag
Lipstick	allowed in hand luggage
Liquid medication such as ointments, creams	amount sufficient for the flight allowed in hand luggage; does not need to be transported in a plastic bag; medical certificate or prescription not required; recommendation: transport in original package
Marmalade, jam	not allowed in hand luggage if over 100 ml
Matches	allowed in hand luggage except for non-safety matches (forbidden in hand or checked luggage)
Pacemaker	no restrictions; please notify security personnel so that the metal detector can be switched off, pacemaker ID card not necessary as manual check is carried out

Razorblades	not allowed in hand luggage
Sachertorte	allowed in hand luggage
Sausage meat	firm sausage meat (e.g. salami) allowed, sausage spread: max. 100 ml in 1 litre plastic bag
Solid food such as bread, cereal	allowed in hand luggage
Solid medication such as tablets	no restrictions
Syringes, insulin, thrombosis medication	allowed in hand luggage, see liquid medication
Umbrella (rigid or collapsible)	allowed in hand luggage
